
Estimated costs for the Second Preparatory Meeting for the Third Review Conference of the States Parties to the Convention on the prohibition of the use, stockpiling, production and transfer of anti-personnel mines and on their destruction and its

## Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The Thirteenth Meeting of the States Parties to the Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction, held in Geneva, from 2 to 5 December 2013, decided to convene the Third Review Conference of the States Parties to the Convention in Maputo, Mozambique, from 23 to 27 June 2014. The Meeting further decided to convene a Second Preparatory Meeting in advance of the Third Review Conference in Geneva, Switzerland, on 10 April 2014.
- 2. This document is submitted pursuant to the above-mentioned decision and provides estimated costs in the amount of **US\$158,500** for conference and non-conference servicing of the Preparatory Meeting. A breakdown of these costs is provided in the attached table. It should be noted that the costs are estimated on the basis of past experience and anticipated workload. The actual costs will be determined after the closing of the Meeting when the exact workload is known. At that time, any adjustments in contributions by the participants sharing the costs will be made accordingly.
- 3. With regard to the financial arrangements, it will be recalled that, in accordance with article 14 (1) of the Convention, "the costs... shall be borne by the States Parties and States not parties to this Convention participating therein, in accordance with the United Nations scale of assessment adjusted appropriately".
- 4. Since preparations for the Preparatory Meeting will involve costs that will need to be defrayed beforehand, and as the holding the Meeting shall have no financial implications for the regular budget of the United Nations, the Secretariat will prepare and issue assessment notices as soon as the Thirteenth Meeting of the States Parties has accepted the attached estimated costs in accordance with the established practice.
