Paragraph 25

The paragraph should read as follows:

San Marino reported that it had no specific laws or legal texts on terrorism but terrorist actions are contemplated under more general provisions of the Criminal Code. Because of its small territorial dimensions, it does not have airports, train stations or other locations in which terrorist actions generally take place. The Government is examining the possibility of adhering, in the near future, to the conventions related to the matter.
