## **Appointment of a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee**

### **Note by the Secretary-General**

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Susan McLurg (United States of America) from membership in the United Nations Staff Pension Committee. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required, at its current session, to appoint a person to fill the remainder of the term of office of Ms. McLurg, which expires on 31 December 2004.
2. The Government of the United States of America has nominated Thomas Repasch to fill the vacancy.
3. The candidature of Mr. Repasch has been endorsed by the Western European and other States Group.
