Organization of the fifty-seventh regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Third report of the General Committee

At its 1st meeting, on 11 September 2002, the General Committee decided (A/57/250, para. 71) to defer its consideration of the inclusion of the item entitled "Question of the Comorian island of Mayotte" to a later date. At its 4th meeting, on 15 October 2002, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that this item be deferred to the fifty-eighth session of the Assembly and that it be included in the provisional agenda of that session.

Also at its 4th meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Peru (A/57/232) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"South American Zone of Peace and Cooperation".

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.
