Admission of new Members to the United Nations**Letter dated 24 July 2002 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General**

I have the honour to request you to transmit the text of Security Council resolution 1426 (2002) on the admission of the Swiss Confederation to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Council at its 4585th meeting on 24 July 2002, to the fifty-seventh session of the General Assembly:

“Recommends to the General Assembly that the Swiss Confederation be admitted to membership in the United Nations.”
