1. Page 1, summary, first paragraph

The second sentence should read

OAU, as it was previously structured, was brought to an end on 8 July 2002, while the African Union was born on 9 July.

2. Page 1, summary, second paragraph

After the last sentence, add

At its 110th plenary meeting, on 15 August 2002, the General Assembly decided that the African Union would assume the rights and responsibilities of the Organization of African Unity, as well as the cooperation agreement between the United Nations and the Organization of African Unity (see decision 56/475). The present report covers the activities undertaken during the transitional phase from the Organization of African Unity to the African Union.

3. Paragraph 2

After the last sentence, add

At its 110th plenary meeting, on 15 August 2002, the General Assembly considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/56/1024) transmitting information received from the Interim Chairperson of the Commission of the African Union to the effect that, as of 8 July 2002, the Organization of African Unity had ceased to exist and that the African Union had come into force as of 9 July 2002. At the same meeting, the General Assembly
