Financial situation of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women

Twenty-eighth report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financial situation of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women (INSTRAW) (A/57/797). During its consideration of the report, the Advisory Committee met with representatives of the Secretary-General who provided additional information.

2. In the report, the Secretary-General stated that an amount of \$481,900 was available, which was sufficient to maintain INSTRAW operations, including the payment of salaries of eight staff members, until the end of November 2003 (*ibid.*, para. 6). **Accordingly, the Advisory Committee recommends that the General Assembly take note of the report of the Secretary-General and request him to report further on the financial situation of the Institute at its fifty-eighth session.**
