## Memorandum by the Secretary-General

## Addendum

1. By a communication received on 12 June 2003, the Permanent Mission of Burkina Faso to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that Mr. Abdoulaye Barry had decided to withdraw his candidature.

2. By a communication received on 13 June 2003, the Permanent Mission of Chad to the United Nations informed the Secretariat that Ms. Achta Saker Abdoul, Mr. Edouard Ngarta Mbaïouroum and Mr. Laurent Ngaoundi had decided to withdraw their candidatures.

3. In consequence, the following candidates should be deleted from the list of candidates for ad litem judges of the International Tribunal for Rwanda appearing in paragraph 7 of document A/57/801:

Mr. Laurent Ngaoundi (Chad)
