### **Financing of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States between 1 January and 31 December 1994**

## **Note by the Secretary-General\*\***

The General Assembly, in its resolution 57/289, invited the Security Council to address uncertainties arising from issues identified in paragraphs 8, 42 and 43 of the report of the Secretary-General on the long-term financial obligations of the United Nations with regard to the enforcement of sentences (A/57/347). As of 12 September 2003, the Security Council has taken no action on the invitation of the General Assembly.

The Secretary-General proposes, therefore, that the General Assembly continue the temporary arrangements referred to in paragraph 9 of resolution 57/289, for which resources in the amount of \$250,000 are included in the proposed budget for the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda for 2004-2005.
