### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

1. At its 28th and 30th meetings on 16 and 23 December 2003, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/58/18) of the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.6/58/L.18. At the 28th meeting, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/58/7/Add.13). The draft decision submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations was before the Committee (see A/C.5/58/L.53, sect. A).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/58/SR.28 and 30).

### **Decision of the Fifth Committee**
