Organization of the fifty-ninth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 4th meeting, on 13 October 2004, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Saint Lucia (A/59/233) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Observer status for the Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States in the General Assembly”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters);
- (b) Be allocated to the Sixth Committee.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee, on the proposal of Canada (A/59/424), decided to recommend to the General Assembly that agenda item 21 (The role of diamonds in fuelling conflict) and agenda item 24 (Prevention of armed conflict) be considered separately.

3. At the same meeting, the General Committee took note of the information that agenda item 21 and agenda item 24 would be rescheduled separately at a later date to be announced.
