Allocation of agenda items for the sixtieth session of the General Assembly

Addendum

At its 88th plenary meeting, on 6 June 2006, the General Assembly decided to consider directly in plenary meeting, under heading B (Promotion of sustained economic growth and sustainable development in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly and recent United Nations conferences), the following sub-item in the agenda of its sixtieth session, which had been allocated to the Second Committee:

54. Globalization and interdependence:

(c) International migration and development.

At the same, meeting, the General Assembly further decided to consider directly in plenary meeting, under heading G (Disarmament), the following sub-item in the agenda of its sixtieth session, which had been allocated to the First Committee:

97. General and complete disarmament:

(i) convening of the fourth special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament.

Also at the same meeting, the General Assembly, on the proposal of the Secretary-General (A/60/238), decided to consider directly in plenary meeting the following item in the agenda of its sixtieth session under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters):

161. Extension of the term of the permanent judges of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States between 1 January and 31 December 1994.
