Groups of countries in special situations

Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 1st plenary meeting, on 13 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixtieth session the item entitled:

“Groups of countries in special situations:

“(a) Third United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries;

“(b) Specific actions related to the particular needs and problems of landlocked developing countries: outcome of the International Ministerial Conference of Landlocked and Transit Developing Countries and Donor Countries and International Financial and Development Institutions on Transit Transport Cooperation”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 26th and 27th meetings, on 10 November 2005. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/60/SR.26 and 27). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 7th meetings, from 3 to 5 October (see A/C.2/60/SR.2-7).
