

Eradication of poverty and other development issues

Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 1st plenary meeting, on 13 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixtieth session the item entitled:

"Eradication of poverty and other development issues:

- (a) Implementation of the first United Nations Decade for the Eradication of Poverty (1997-2006);
- (b) Women in development;
- (c) Human resources development;"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee considered the item at its 29th, 30th, 32nd, 33rd, 34th and 39th meetings, on 14, 15 and 23 November and on 2, 7 and 19 December 2005. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/60/SR.29, 30, 32, 33, 34 and 39). - 4. At the 29th meeting, on 14 November, the reports were introduced by the Assistant Secretary-General for Economic Development and the Director of the Division for the Advancement of Women of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (see A/C.2/60/SR.29).
- 5. At the same meeting, pursuant to section C, paragraph 3 (d), of the annex to General Assembly resolution 58/316, the Committee held a dialogue with the representatives, during which comments were made and questions were posed by the representatives of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the European Union), Guyana and France (see A/C.2/60/SR.29).
- 6. Also at the same meeting, the Under-Secretary-General and High Representative for the Least Developed Countries, Landlocked Developing Countries and Small Island Developing States made a statement (see A/C.2/60/SR.29).
