Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 1st plenary meeting, on 13 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixtieth session the item entitled:

“Training and research:

“(a) United Nations Institute for Training and Research;

“(b) United Nations System Staff College in Turin, Italy”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.
