Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 17th plenary meeting, on 20 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixtieth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. At its 20th meeting, on 3 November, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
 - (a) Note by the Secretary-General on appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission (A/60/105);
 - (b) Note by the Secretary-General on appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission (A/C.5/60/8).
3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the appointment of Minoru Endo (Japan), Gilberto Paranhos Velloso (Brazil), Lucretia Myers (United States of America), Wolfgang Stockl (Germany) and Gian Luigi Valenza (Italy) as members of the Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2006 (see para. 4).
