

## **Report of the Fifth Committee**

1. At its 35th and 36th meetings, on 21 and 23 December 2005, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the oral statement on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/60/L.43. At the 35th meeting, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/60/7/Add.30). The draft decision submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations was before the Committee (see para. 3).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/60/SR.35 and 36).

## **Decision of the Fifth Committee**

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the oral statement of programme budget implications of draft resolution A/60/L.43, on the preparations for and organization of the 2006 follow-up meeting on the implementation of the
