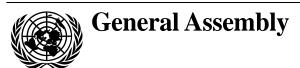

Addendum

- 1. At its 57th plenary meeting, on 22 November 2006, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee (A/61/250/Add.3), decided to also consider directly in plenary meeting the following item of the agenda of its sixty-first session for the sole purpose of taking action during the main part of the sixty-first session on the draft convention on the rights of persons with disabilities that is expected to be recommended by the Ad Hoc Committee on a Comprehensive and Integral International Convention on the Protection and Promotion of the Rights and Dignity of Persons with Disabilities in its report:
 - 67 (b) Human rights questions, including alternative approaches for improving the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms.
- 2. At the same meeting the General Assembly, also on the recommendation of the General Committee (A/61/250/Add.3), decided to consider directly in plenary meeting the following item of the agenda of its sixty-first session under heading B (Promotion of sustained economic growth and sustainable development in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly and recent United Nations conferences):
 - 157. Support by the United Nations system of the efforts of Governments to promote and consolidate new or restored democracies.
