## Globalization and interdependence

### Report of the Second Committee\*

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 13 September 2006, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-first session the item entitled:

“Globalization and interdependence:

“(a) Globalization and interdependence;

“(b) International migration and development;

“(c) Culture and development;

“(d) Preventing and combating corrupt practices and transfer of assets of illicit origin and returning such assets, in particular to the countries of origin, consistent with the United Nations Convention against Corruption;

“(e) Integration of the economies in transition into the world economy”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 15th to 18th meetings, on 19, 20 and 23 October.
