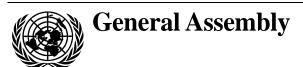

I. Introduction

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 13 September 2006, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-first session the item entitled "Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 19th and 31st meetings, on 9 November and 13 December 2006. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/61/SR.19 and 31).
- 3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system (A/61/203 and Corr.1-2).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/61/L.7

- 4. At its 31st meeting, on 13 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision submitted by the Chairman entitled "Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system" (A/C.5/61/L.7).
- 5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/61/L.7 without a vote (see para. 6).



III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system

The General Assembly takes note of the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system. ¹
