Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2007, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-second session the item entitled:

“Eradication of poverty and other development issues:

“(a) Implementation of the first United Nations Decade for the Eradication of Poverty (1997-2006);

“(b) Women in development;

“(c) Human resources development”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 23rd, 24th and 25th meetings, on 6 and 8 November 2007. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/62/SR.23-25).
