Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2008, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-third session the item entitled:

“Macroeconomic policy questions:

“(a) International trade and development;

“(b) International financial system and development;

“(c) External debt and development: towards a durable solution to the debt problems of developing countries;

“(d) Commodities”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate jointly on sub-items (b) to (d) at its 7th and 8th meetings, on 13 October 2008, and on sub-item (a) at its 25th and 26th meetings, on 5 November. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/63/SR.7, 8, 25 and 26). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 6th meetings, from 6 to 8 October (see A/C.2/63/SR.2-6). At the 7th meeting, on 13 October, introductory statements were made under sub-items (b) to (d) by the Chief of the Policy Analysis and Development Branch of the Financing for Development Office of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, the Chief of the Debt and Development Finance Branch of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) and the Head of the Special Unit on Commodities of UNCTAD (see A/C.2/63/SR.7).

At the same meeting, the Chief of the Policy Analysis and Development Branch of the Financing for Development Office of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, the Chief of the Debt and Development Finance Branch of UNCTAD and the Head of the Special Unit on Commodities of UNCTAD responded to questions and comments made by the representatives of Antigua and Barbuda (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China), Nigeria and Benin (see A/C.2/63/SR.7).
