

The paragraph should read

57. It is also notable that a number of studies have shown that the current multilateral debt relief initiatives are ineffective. For example, a recent study by Erlassjahr and the Friedrich-Ebert Foundation, which assessed the vulnerability of the 24 post-Heavily Indebted Poor Countries Initiative (HIPC) countries, shows that more than half of HIPC countries are at risk of entering a new phase of the debt crisis. 40 Given that HIPC was designed to offer a permanent "exit" from unsustainable debt, there is need for an alternative fair and transparent debt workout mechanism.
