## Globalization and interdependence

### Report of the Second Committee\*

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 18 September 2009, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-fourth session the item entitled:

“Globalization and interdependence:

“(a) Role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence;

“(b) Preventing and combating corrupt practices and transfer of assets of illicit origin and returning such assets, in particular to the countries of origin, consistent with the United Nations Convention against Corruption;

“(c) Science and technology for development”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on sub-items (b) and (c) at its 16th and 17th meetings, on 21 October 2009, and on sub-item (a) at its 23rd and 24th meetings, on 28 October. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/64/SR.16, 17, 23 and 24). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 7th meetings, from 5 to 7 October (see A/C.2/64/SR.2-7). An account of the Committee’s further consideration of the item will be provided in the addenda to the present report.
