Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 32nd meeting, on 16 May 2013, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/67/102/Add.1) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the resignation of NneNne Iwuji-Eme (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland). By that note, the Fifth Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of the United Kingdom of Thomas David Smith to fill the remainder of the term of office of Ms. Iwuji-Eme, which expires on 31 December 2014. By that same note, the Fifth Committee was informed that the candidature of Mr. Smith had been endorsed by the Group of Western European and other States.

2. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Smith as a member of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on _____ 2013¹ and ending on 31 December 2014 (see para. 3 below).

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint Thomas David Smith (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) as a member of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on _____ 2013¹ and ending on 31 December 2014.
