Agenda and programme of work for 2015

The agenda for the substantive session of 2015 of the Committee on Conferences was approved by the Committee at its organizational session, on 22 April 2015, on the basis of an annotated provisional agenda proposed by the Secretariat (see [A/AC.172/2015/L.1](#), annex). Subsequently, a revision to the agenda for the substantive session became necessary owing to a need to add the following item: Election of officers. The revised agenda is issued in the present document for consideration and approval by the Committee.

All matters pertaining to conference management and regularly reported under the agenda item “Pattern of conferences” have been included in one consolidated report ([A/70/122](#)). Statistical and other relevant data have been provided as information supplementary to the report. The draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2016 and 2017 has been issued ([A/AC.172/2015/L.2](#)). At its organizational session, the Committee also decided, as it had in previous years, to include in its programme of work for the year informal briefings by the Secretariat on issues related to conference management of interest to Member States. In preparation for the substantive session, a briefing by the Secretariat is proposed for 3 September 2015. Other briefings may be scheduled at the request of Member States.

At its organizational session, the Committee also reconfirmed the dates for its substantive session, to be held from 8 to 14 September 2015. The programme of work will follow the same pattern as in previous years: the Committee will meet formally on 8 and 9 September and will hold informal consultations, as required, on 10 and 11 September before concluding its work on 14 September.

The election will be held at the opening of the substantive session of the Committee, on 8 September 2015.

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to paragraphs 14 to 21, 23 and 27 of General Assembly resolution 69/250.

Documentation: Statistical data and analysis of the planned and actual utilization of conference-servicing resources allocated to a core sample of bodies at all four duty stations will be made available to the Committee as supplementary information. The Chair will report orally on consultations with bodies in New York and on written communications with bodies at other duty stations that have underutilized their conference-servicing resources.

(ii) Provision of interpretation services to meetings of bodies entitled to meet “as required”

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to paragraph 22 of General Assembly resolution 69/250.

(iii) Provision of interpretation services to meetings of regional and other major groupings of Member States

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to paragraphs 24 to 26 of General Assembly resolution 69/250.

(iv) Utilization of conference facilities at the United Nations Office at Nairobi

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to paragraph 28 of General Assembly resolution 69/250.

(v) Utilization of the conference centre at the Economic Commission for Africa

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to paragraphs 29 to 33 of General Assembly resolution 69/250.

(b) Impact of the capital master plan, strategy IV (phased approach), on meetings held at Headquarters during its implementation

The Secretariat will report on the matter pursuant to section II.B of General Assembly resolution 69/250.
