May I also draw your attention to the relevant parts of sections IV and V of the report concerning the agenda of the Main Committees.

### Allocation of items to the Second Committee

1. Election of the officers of the Main Committees [item 5].

#### A. Maintenance of international peace and security

2. Permanent sovereignty of the Palestinian people in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and of the Arab population in the occupied Syrian Golan over their natural resources [item 38].

#### **B.** Promotion of sustained economic growth and sustainable development in accordance with the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly and recent United Nations conferences

3. Information and communication technologies for development [item 49].

[In accordance with decision 58/569 of 1 July 2004, the General Assembly will consider the report of the World Summit on the Information Society directly in plenary meeting at its sixtieth session.]

- 4. Macroeconomic policy questions [item 50]:
  - (a) International trade and development;
  - (b) International financial system and development;
  - (c) External debt crisis and development.
- 5. Follow-up to and implementation of the outcome of the International Conference on Financing for Development [item 51].

[In accordance with paragraph 4 of resolution 59/145, the General Assembly held on 14 September 2005 a separate meeting on Financing for Development within the framework of the High-level Plenary Meeting of the sixtieth session of the General Assembly.]

- 6. Sustainable development [item 52]:
  - (a) Implementation of Agenda 21, the Programme for the Further Implementation of Agenda 21 and the outcomes of the World Summit on Sustainable Development;
