**Reliable transit of energy and its role in ensuring stable economic development and international cooperation**

*The General Assembly,*

*Bearing in mind* the growing role of the transit of energy in global political and economic processes,

*Observing* that Central Asia today is a major Eurasian transportation and communication hub and one of the largest centres for the production of energy and its transportation to international markets,

*Noting* that stable and reliable energy transportation, as a key factor of sustainable development, is in the interest of the entire international community,

1. *Welcomes* international cooperation in developing transportation systems and pipelines;

2. *Supports* the need for extensive international cooperation in determining ways to ensure the reliability of pipelines transporting energy to international markets;

3. *Welcomes* the initiative of Turkmenistan to convene an international conference of energy-producing and energy-transporting countries to discuss the issue of ensuring the reliable transportation of energy to international markets.
