Promotion of the Declaration on the Right and Responsibility of Individuals, Groups and Organs of Society to Promote and Protect Universally Recognized Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms: protecting women human rights defenders

Replace the thirteenth preambular paragraph with the following text:

Stressing the obligation of States to take all measures necessary for the protection by the competent authorities of everyone against any violence, threat, retaliation, de facto or de jure adverse discrimination, pressure or any other arbitrary action as a consequence of his or her legitimate exercise of the right to participate in peaceful activities against violations of human rights and fundamental freedoms, as well as against acts of violence perpetrated by groups or individuals that affect the enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms, including women human rights defenders, who face particular risks of violence;
