**Draft resolution submitted by the Vice-Chairman following
informal consultations**

Feasibility of consolidating the accounts of the various peacekeeping operations

The General Assembly,

Recalling paragraph 10 of its resolution 56/293 of 27 June 2002,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the feasibility of consolidating the accounts of the various peacekeeping operations¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,²

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on the feasibility of consolidating the accounts of the various peacekeeping operations¹ and of the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;²

2. *Decides* to defer consideration of this question to the second part of its resumed fifty-eighth session, and requests the Secretary-General to provide a comprehensive report, taking into account the views expressed, questions raised and information requested by Member States at its fifty-seventh session, including a simulation of the options proposed.
