Draft resolution submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations

## Estimates in respect of special political missions, good offices and other political initiatives authorized by the General Assembly and/or the Security Council

The General Assembly,

*Having considered* the report of the Secretary-General on the estimates in respect of special political missions, good offices and other political initiatives authorized by the General Assembly and/or the Security Council<sup>1</sup> and the oral statement made by the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

1. *Emphasizes* the importance of the work of the good offices of the Secretary-General in support of the work of Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission;

2. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on estimates in respect of special political missions, good offices and other political initiatives authorized by the General Assembly and/or the Security Council;<sup>1</sup>

3. *Notes with concern* the late submission of the report of the Secretary-General;

4. *Endorses* the observations and recommendations as orally presented by the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup> subject to the provisions of the present resolution;

5. *Requests* the Secretary-General to provide to the General Assembly, by the end of its fifty-eighth session, a comprehensive financial report on the requirements for United Nations support to the Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission, including clearly defined requirements to be provided from the regular

budget and elements being financed from other sources, for its consideration at the early part of the fifty-ninth session;

6. *Authorizes* the Secretary-General to enter into commitments in an amount of 6 million United States dollars for United Nations support to the Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission until 30 November 2004, on the understanding that any decision on further financing must be taken by 31 October 2004;

7. *Urges* the Secretary-General to seek further voluntary contributions for the United Nations support to the Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission.
