Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/60/L.40

The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,² decides to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of draft resolution A/60/L.40 would not give rise to any additional requirements under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007 at the present stage. Any additional resources as may be necessary for conference-servicing of the Peacebuilding Commission should be reported in the first performance report. Further, in view of the requirement that the peacebuilding support office be staffed from within existing resources, there should not be any additional appropriation under section 3, Political affairs, of the proposed programme budget for 2006-2007 at this stage. The General Assembly requests the Secretary-General to report back to it pursuant to paragraph 7 of the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions.
