Final record of the one thousand and hundred and eighty-sixth plenary meeting

Held at the Palais des Nations, Geneva, on Tuesday, 22 June 2010, at 10.10 a.m.

President: Mr. Luiz Filipe de Macedo Soares(Brazil)

The President: I declare open the 1186th plenary meeting of the Conference on Disarmament.

During the days since our last plenary, I have started consulting all the delegations individually about the possibility of adopting a programme of work as early as possible during the Brazilian presidency or, if that cannot be done, in a subsequent presidency.

I am grateful to the delegations that have accepted my invitation. I am very pleased with the conversations I have had and I am looking forward to receiving the remaining delegations. The order is, of course, random, but I need to make personal contact with each individual delegation.

I do not have any speakers scheduled for today's plenary but, in any case, I offer the floor to any delegation that would like to express itself at this point. It seems that no delegation desires to take the floor.

In that case, I will just announce that the next formal plenary meeting of the Conference will be held on Tuesday, 29 June, at 10 a.m. in this same Council chamber.

The meeting stands adjourned.
