The paragraph should read

Ireland continues to regard the Conference on Disarmament as having the potential to serve as an important tool in maintaining international peace and security. We remain convinced that multilateral cooperation is in the interests of all. We have placed our faith in the multilateral regime of disarmament and non-proliferation treaties and agreements. We are committed to implementing and strengthening these instruments and to pursuing the universalization of their norms. We believe that the validity of this collective rules-based approach persists, notwithstanding the new security permutations which have emerged since the end of the “cold war”. We are not averse to approaches which are innovative or otherwise take new challenges into consideration. But we are not attracted to throwing away the rule book, we do not wish to ignore our agenda and the objectives of this Conference.
