Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. In its resolution 35/81 of 5 December 1980, the General Assembly requested the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation annually to submit to it a report containing comprehensive statistical information on operational activities for development of the United Nations system.
2. Owing to technical problems, complete information for the year 1986 could not be incorporated in the report submitted to the Assembly at its forty-second session (A/42/326/Add.3-E/1987/82/Add.?). The full details, including revision of some figures previously published, are now being made available to Member States as a complement to that report.
3. At the same time, the opportunity has been taken to make some changes in the presentation and explanation of the data, which will be utilized in the preparation of the comprehensive statistical data for 1987 and subsequent years.



OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN THE UNITED NATIONS SYSTEM: A QUICK GUIDE

1. A variety of resource flows, domestic and external, public and private, commercial and charitable, serve to promote the economic and social advancement of developing countries. Of these, official development assistance (ODA) channelled through bilateral and multilateral institutions is an important source, comprising about \$44 billion in 1986. About 15 per cent of total ODA is provided through the financial institutions and the organizations of the United Nations system, divided about half and half between grants and concessional loans. a/

2. As indicated in detail in the present document, expenditures on operational activities through the United Nations system comprise: development-related grants; concessional loans; non-concessional loans; and refugee, humanitarian and special economic assistance and disaster relief. These totalled about \$6.6 billion in 1986. (For loan expenditures, net transfers only were counted.) The composition of this was: development grants \$2.6 billion, concessional loans \$3 billion, non-concessional loans \$0.4 billion and grant-financed refugee, humanitarian, special economic and disaster relief activities \$0.6 billion. THE UN SYSTEM'S SHARE OF TOTAL ODA, 1986





3. The operational activities of the United Nations system in the largest sense include all of the above. It is however useful to make a distinction on the one hand between grant-financed development activities and provision of humanitarian and relief assistance through UNHCR, UNRWA, UNDRO etc., and on the other hand between such grants and the non-concessional and concessional loans of the World Bank group, including its IDA facility, and of IFAD. b/

4. Another important analytical distinction is to group the concessional loans and development grants of the system and to demarcate these as net transfers of concessional assistance for development. The total came to \$5.5 billion in 1986, of which \$4.9 billion was for individual recipient countries. Development grants comprised roughly two fifths of these amounts.


5. Geographically, almost seven eighths of all the concessional resources were in 1986 allocated to the Asia and Pacific and the Africa regions. Activities in Latin America and the Caribbean, in Western Asia, and in the "interregional, global and other" category accounted for virtually all the rest. (See table B-4.)

UN SYSTEM ASSISTANCE, 1986



6. The United Nations system's strong focus upon assistance to the poorest countries is quite pronounced. Thirty-seven per cent of all concessional development assistance in 1986 was provided to countries classified as "least-developed". Almost half of the total of concessional assistance was for countries where the gross national product (GNP) per capita was \$250 or below; a total of almost seven eighths was for those where GNP per capita did not exceed \$500. A major element in this focus relates to the volume and orientation of IDA net transfers. In 1986 these comprised \$2.8 billion (i.e., almost three fifths of the total concessional assistance). Of that, about three-fifths was devoted to countries where GNP per capita did not exceed \$250. (See table B-7.)


7. Inclusion of the demographic factor permits yet another perspective on the distribution of the system's concessional development assistance. Overall, these resources amounted to \$1.17 per capita in 1986. In the poorest countries the figure was somewhat higher, at \$2.10 per capita. (See table B-8.)

8. Turning now to grant assistance for development, this represents both financial contributions through a range of institutions and the food aid for development projects channelled through WFP. The Resident Co-ordinator of Operational Activities for Development of the United Nations System assumes overall leadership in the organization of such assistance at the country level as well as of some relief activities. As earlier indicated, the total contribution represents, on the average, about 7 per cent of total ODA to each developing country.

9. The distribution of grant expenditures in support of development activities in 1986 was: UNDP, including UNDP-administered funds, \$776 million, WFP \$648 million, extrabudgetary (XB) including agency trust funds and government "self-supporting" funds \$451 million, UNICEF \$326 million, regular budget (RB) \$257 million, and UNFPA \$102 million.

10. Some 60 per cent of 1986 country-level expenditures benefited from integrated general policy and management advice from the UNDP Resident Representative who also serves as the official field representative for WFP and UNFPA. The UNDP Governing Council - holding review authority for the UNDP main programme, UNDP-administered funds and UNFPA - was responsible in 1986 for monitoring the expenditure of 35 per cent of such development activities.


THE PRINCIPAL CHANNELS OF

FOR DEVELOPMENT, 1986




11. The sectoral coverage of the system's grant-funded development assistance is wide-ranging, but with strong emphasis upon the agriculture/forestry/fisheries and the health-related programme classification categories. (See table B-6.) Other areas of importance in 1986 included natural resources; transport and communications; general development issues, policy and planning; industry; education; social conditions and equity, population and human settlements.

12. The application of the term "technical co-operation" to the analysis of operational activities leads to a somewhat different demarcation, in which the food aid of WFP is excluded, but the expenditures on training and consultants included in World Bank loans and IDA credits are included. Such use of World Bank/IDA funds is estimated to have amounted to \$1.1 billion gross disbursements in 1986. According to this formulation, total United Nations system technical co-operation expenditures were \$3 billion, distributed among World Bank/IDA, UNDP and UNDP-administered funds, XB, UNICEF, RB and UNFPA. It should be noted that while World Bank/IDA technical co-operation-type expenditures are larger than those of UNDP, they are made through loans and credits to Governments and represent, on the whole, integral parts of specific investment projects.

INCLUDING WORLD BANK/IDA, 1986




13. Implementation of the grant-financed development activities is undertaken by 28 organizations and agencies of the system, together with Governments, some NGOs and other non-United Nations entities. (see table B-5.) The major channels for such expenditures in 1986 were: WFP (\$648 million); c/ UNICEF (\$326 million); c/ WHO (\$323 million); FAO (\$317 million); DTCD (\$144 million); UNDP (\$112 million); ILO (\$105 million); UNIDO (\$97 million); UNESCO (\$77 million); ICAO (\$50 million) and World Bank (\$49 million). Government execution accounted for \$79 million. The total for all other agencies was \$232 million.

14. UNDP (including the UNDP-administered funds) has a central funding and co-ordinating role for technical co-operation within the United Nations system, and to this effect maintains strong linkages with the relevant agencies on substantive aspects of its work. In addition, the United Nations specialized agencies are responsible for the execution of 78 per cent of UNDP-funded programmes. UNFPA, though focused on one sector also channels its expenditures through a dozen United Nations agencies, as well as Governments; it also undertakes direct execution for some 11 per cent of its expenditures.

15. Twenty-five organizations of the United Nations system are executing agencies for UNDP. Seven of these agencies, plus Governments and UNDP itself, delivered at least \$35 million of UNDP main programme resources in 1986. Their shares of the total delivery for UNDP were FAO \$129 million (19 per cent), DTCD

DEVELOPMENT, 1986





\$101 million (15 per cent), UNIDO
\$72 million (11 per cent), UNDP \$64 million
(9 per cent), ILO \$46 million (7 per cent),
World Bank \$44 million (6 per cent),
Governments \$41 million (6 per cent), ICAO
\$35 million (5 per cent) and UNESCO
\$35 million (5 per cent). The total of all
others amounted to \$115 million
(17 per cent).

16. UNDP and UNDP-administered funds
financed 69 per cent of the technical
co-operation expenditures of 22 of the
above 25 United Nations system
organizations in 1986. When expenditures
for UNFPA are added, the result is that the
Governing Council had within its purview,
for these 22 institutions, the funding of
75 per cent of their expenditures on
operational activities, for a total of
\$606 million.

17. At the same time, the significance of
the UNDP central funding role, and of the
UNDP Governing Council, must be seen in
relation to both the volume and the
distribution of RB and XB expenditures.
Taken together these expenditures, which
are implemented according to the mandates
and procedures of each agency, are as great
as the resources managed by UNDP. WHO is
mandated to devote at least 60 per cent of
its regular budget resources to development
co-operation, and has by far the largest RB
programme. That of IAEA represents an even
greater proportion of its expenditures on
technical co-operation. FAO and WHO also
have major XB support. The combination of
RB and XB expenditures for WHO, IAEA and
FAO was \$505 million in 1986, representing
74 per cent of the total disbursed through
those three agencies.

NOTE ON STATISTICAL INFORMATION

General note

1. Coverage, definition and sources for the figures used in this report are consistent with those for previous years' reports in this series. Modifications have been made to data presentation, column headings and table titles in the interest of greater clarity and internal consistency. Explanations of special cases, or of reasons for non-matching between table totals, have been given attention in the footnotes to tables.

Definitions and explanations

2. For information on the sources of data, see paragraph 45 of the first (1981) annual report (A/36/478, annex) and the footnotes to the tables.

3. The data represent final figures for 1986. Should any further revisions or updating later prove necessary this would be communicated to the General Assembly.

4. Data on contributions refer to contributions received from Governments and other sources by organizations in the United Nations system. Data on other income, related to resource transfers from one agency of the system to another, interest, etc., or the net profits from the UNICEF greeting card operation, are excluded. Data on expenditures and disbursements represent the support provided by organizations to the programmes and projects of developing countries; administrative, programme and other support costs, where identifiable, are excluded. UNICEF and WFP carry out both development assistance and some activities which are of a humanitarian and/or emergency character. To the extent possible the related contributions and expenditures are separately identified. With regard to loans, net disbursements represent gross disbursements less repayment of principal; net transfers represent net disbursements less interest and other charges.

5. The expression "United Nations funds and programmes" refers to the funds and programmes listed by the General Assembly for participation in the annual United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities, and to other United Nations trust funds pertaining to development activities.

6. The designations employed and the presentation of the material in the present report do not imply the expression of any opinion whatsoever on the part of the Secretariat of the United Nations concerning the legal status of any country, territory, city or area or of its authorities, or concerning the delimitation of its frontiers or boundaries.

7. The term "country" as used in the present report also refers, as appropriate, to territories or areas.

8. References to dollars (\$) are to United States dollars unless otherwise stated. A full stop is used to indicate decimals. Two dots (..) indicate that data are not available or are not separately reported. Parentheses () indicate a deficit or decrease, except as otherwise indicated. A dash (-) indicates that the amount is nil or negligible or the item is not applicable. A hyphen (-) between dates representing years signifies the full period involved, including the beginning and end years.

9. Details and percentages in tables do not necessarily add to totals, because of rounding.


Chart 1. Contributions from governments and other sources for operational activities for development of the United Nations system:

(millions of US dollars)


I. Contributions to UN funds and programmes






