International Labour Organization

In 2010, the International Labour Organization (ILO) provided tabulated data and supporting information with regard to the Non-Self-Governing Territories, specifically American Samoa, Anguilla, Bermuda, the British Virgin Islands, the Falkland Islands (Malvinas),¹ Gibraltar, Guam, Montserrat, New Caledonia, Saint Helena, Tokelau and the United States Virgin Islands.

The supporting information listed the various conventions that were applicable to the individual territories and referred to communications with the respective Administering Power (France, New Zealand, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland or the United States of America) commenting on reports received, requesting further information or noting that the information requested had not been forthcoming.
