Election of 19 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 56/206, the Economic and Social Council is to elect, at its resumed organizational session for 2011, 19 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2012 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2011 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Bahrain, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Congo, Germany, Honduras, India, Iraq, Israel, Jamaica, Kenya, Romania, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Sri Lanka, Swaziland and Zambia.
2. In accordance with paragraph 4 of section I.A of General Assembly resolution 56/206, the 19 members are to be elected according to the following pattern:
 - (a) Five seats for African States;
 - (b) Five seats for Asian States;
 - (c) Two seats for Eastern European States;
 - (d) Three seats for Latin American and Caribbean States;
 - (e) Four seats for Western European and other States.
3. The membership of the Governing Council in 2011 is listed in the annex to the present note.
