Annotations

1. Election of officers

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representatives of its members a Chair, one or more Vice-Chairs and such other officers as may be required. Following the established practice, the Commission shall elect a Chair and four Vice-Chairs and also designate one of the Vice-Chairs as Rapporteur (Vice-Chair-and-Rapporteur).

In subparagraph (c) of its decision 2002/210, the Economic and Social Council decided that, immediately following the closure of a regular session, the Commission for Social Development would hold the first meeting of its subsequent regular session for the sole purpose of electing the new Chair and other members of the Bureau. In its resolution 2010/10, the Council recommended that, in order to enhance the effectiveness of the work of the Commission, the officers elected to the Bureau of the Commission serve for a term of office of two years, in parallel with the review and policy cycle.

Accordingly, the Commission held the first meeting of its fiftieth session on 18 February 2011, immediately following the closure of the forty-ninth session, and re-elected by acclamation Jorge Valero (Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela) as Chair of the Commission and Olisa Cifligu (Albania), Susanne Fries-Gaier (Germany), Eduardo Meñez (Philippines) and Najla Abdelrahman (Sudan) as Vice-Chairs. Subsequently, upon the resignation of Mr. Meñez, the Asian States nominated Ana Marie Hernando (Philippines) to represent their regional group on the Bureau as Vice-Chair. At the opening meeting of the fiftieth session of the Commission, on 1 February 2012, the nominee will be elected as Vice-Chair. At the same meeting, the Commission will designate one of its Vice-Chairs as having rapporteurial responsibilities.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda. The provisional agenda and documentation for the fiftieth session of the Commission were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2011/255.

The proposed organization of work of the Commission at its fiftieth session (see annex I) has been prepared pursuant to relevant decisions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within the time frame available and in accordance with the conference services allocated to the Commission. The timetable should be considered tentative and indicative: if the Commission completes its consideration of an item ahead of schedule, it may wish to proceed immediately to the next item.

The Commission is scheduled to meet from Wednesday, 1 February, to Friday, 10 February 2012. Arrangements have been made to hold morning and afternoon meetings during the session: morning meetings will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and afternoon meetings from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

3. Follow-up to the World Summit for Social Development and the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 55/46 on the implementation of the outcome of the World Summit for Social Development and of the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly entitled "World Summit for Social Development and beyond: achieving social development for all in a globalizing world", the Commission will undertake regular assessment of the implementation of the Copenhagen commitments and the further initiatives adopted at Geneva.

(a) Priority theme: poverty eradication

In its resolution 2010/10, the Economic and Social Council decided that the priority theme for the 2011-2012 review and policy cycle would be poverty eradication, taking into account its interrelationship with social integration and full employment and decent work for all. The Commission reviewed the theme at its forty-ninth session in 2011 and will complete the biennial cycle by adopting action-oriented policy recommendations on poverty eradication at its fiftieth session in 2012. The Commission will have before it the report of the Secretary-General on the priority theme.
