Letter dated 23 July 2007 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1760 (2007) concerning Liberia, adopted on 20 June 2007, by which the Council requested me to establish, for a period of six months, a Panel of Experts consisting of up to three members with the range of expertise necessary to fulfil the mandate described in that resolution.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1521 (2003) concerning Liberia, I have appointed the following persons to serve on the Panel of Experts for a period ending on 20 December 2007:

Mr. Dimieari Von Kemedi (Nigeria, expert on arms) Mr. Rajiva Bhushan Sinha (India, expert on finance) Ms. Wynet V. Smith (Canada, expert on natural resources).

I have also selected Mr. Rajiva Bhushan Sinha to chair the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
