## Letter dated 8 July 2010 from the Permanent Representative of Togo to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman

With reference to your letter of 1 February 2010 (S/2010/52) addressed to the President of the Security Council concerning the implementation by Member States of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004), I have the honour to transmit to you the report of the Government of Togo on the matter:

"Togo has never manufactured nor imported weapons of mass destruction, has no such weapons and consequently never uses them.

Implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) in Togo has been effective thanks to the daily protective activity carried out by the Gendarmerie and the Police throughout the country. Strict measures have been taken to strengthen the fight against terrorism and groups promoting fundamentalist uprisings.

The special border services maintain constant monitoring in order to prevent the possible infiltration of any type of weapons of mass destruction or any related items.

A draft law on chemical weapons is being prepared and will be submitted to the National Assembly for adoption."
