I have the honour to refer to the letters dated 2 November 2006 and 30 January 2007 which I addressed to the Registrar of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea and the States parties to the United Nations Convention of the Law of the Sea, respectively, in my capacity as President of the Sixteenth Meeting of States Parties (SPLOS/155, annexes I and II), informing them of the results of my consultations regarding the appointment of a member and an alternate member of the Staff Pension Committee of the Tribunal, pursuant to the decision of the Sixteenth Meeting of States Parties.

Following the submission by Senegal of its nomination as a member of the Committee, I have been informed of the interest of Canada in serving as the alternate member.

In this connection, I wish to propose that the nomination of Senegal and Canada, as member and alternate member respectively of the Staff Pension Committee of the Tribunal, be confirmed by the Seventeenth Meeting of States Parties.
