1. Representatives whose Governments wish to act as host for the Twenty-fourth or a subsequent meeting of Heads of National Drug Law Enforcement Agencies (HONLEA), Africa, are invited to inform the Twenty-third Meeting accordingly. That information will be brought to the attention of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs at its fifty-seventh session, in 2014.
2. The draft provisional agenda for the Twenty-fourth Meeting of HONLEA, Africa, is attached as an annex.
3. Item 4 of the draft provisional agenda is devoted to the examination of the status of implementation of the recommendations adopted at the Twenty-second Meeting. In order to facilitate reporting, a questionnaire concerning action taken by Governments to implement those recommendations will be transmitted together with the invitation to attend the Twenty-fourth Meeting.
4. At the fortieth session of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs, the view was expressed that the recommendations adopted by the meetings of the subsidiary bodies of the Commission would remain meaningless if Governments did not take action, including, where necessary, the enactment of national legislation, to implement those recommendations. States members of HONLEA, Africa, are urged to implement such recommendations conscientiously and promptly so that an effective evaluation of their progress can be made.
5. It would be desirable for the Twenty-third Meeting to identify the topics that would be most appropriate for consideration by working groups at the
