CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT CONVENTION ON THE RECOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT OF FOREIGN ARBITRAL AMARDS (ITEM 4 OF THE AGENDA)

Text of Article VII of the Convention as adopted by the Conference at its 19th meeting

- 1. This Convention shall be sopen until 31 December 1958 for signature, subject to subsequent ratification, on behalf of any Member of the United Nations and also on behalf of any other State which is or hereafter becomes a member of any specialized agency of the United Nations, or which is or hereafter becomes a party to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, or any other State to which an invitation has been addressed by the General Assembly of the United Nations.
- 2. This Convention shall be ratified and the instrument of ratification shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Mations.
