CZECHOSLOVAKIA

1. Czechoslovakia has consistently adhered to the principles and purposes of the Geneva Protocol for the Prohibition of the Use in War of Asphyxiating, Poisonous or Other Gases and of Bacteriological Methods of Warfare, which it signed as early as 1925. Czechoslovakia has always condemned any actions violating the Protocol and advocated elaboration of verification measures which would guarantee strict compliance with its provisions.
2. In this context, Czechoslovakia has welcomed the successful conclusion last year of the work of the expert group of the Secretary-General that prepared, in conformity with General Assembly resolution 42/37 C, technical guidelines and procedures for timely and efficient investigation of reports of possible use of chemical, bacteriological (biological) or toxin weapons (see A/44/561).
3. In reply to the request made in resolution 44/115 B, and in keeping with the elaborated standards (see A/44/561, appendix II and VI), Czechoslovakia is hereby informing the Secretary-General that it is ready to provide two consultants (annex I), 15 qualified experts (annex II) and five laboratories (annex III) for examination and analyses in the event of an investigation of reports of possible use of chemical, bacteriological (biological) or toxin weapons.
4. The selected experts possess extensive knowledge in the fields of analytical and organic chemistry, biochemistry, biology, virology and toxicology. They are prepared to take samples on the spot and to analyse them. If requested, they can travel immediately to a place subjected to investigation. The laboratories are equipped so as to be capable to analyse various chemical and toxic substances and staffed with experienced specialists.
5. The attached list shall be regularly updated and supplemented in accordance with Czechoslovakia's possibilities and with the needs of the Secretary-General as they may develop in future,
