## ANNEX I

### EXPENDITURES UNDER THE REGULAR BUDGET FOR THE YEARS 1969, 1970 AND 1971 BY MAIN ACTIVITY AND PROGRAMME AND BY OBJECT OF EXPENDITURE

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## Introduction

1. The regular budget estimates of the United Nations are presented, in the main, by object of expenditure. This annex provides a distribution of the 1969 expenditures, the 1970 appropriations and the 1971 estimates by main field of activity and programme.

2. As in the case of similar presentations included in the budget submissions for 1969 and 1970, the annex has been prepared in the light of a recommendation contained in the second report of the *Ad Hoc Committee of Experts to Examine the Finances of the United Nations and the Specialized Agencies*,<sup>1</sup> as endorsed by the General Assembly in its resolution 2150 (XXI) of 4 November 1966. Specifically, the *Ad Hoc Committee* proposed that, without disrupting the practices followed by each organization, the organizations should, in the first instance, provide a certain amount of supplementary information for the purpose of imparting greater clarity to the existing budget documents. Thus, the organizations using the traditional budgetary breakdown by object of expenditure should submit, either in the budget itself or in a special document, a breakdown of their expenditure by main fields of activity.

3. In preparing the material for this annex, account has also been taken of the growing demand for consolidated programme and budget presentation, notably as far as the economic, social and human rights activities of the United Nations are concerned. Thus the Economic and Social Council has, for a number of years, been preoccupied with the problem of according priorities to the individual projects and programmes within the resources available in the field of its competence, and has taken a number of initiatives, including requests for a detailed annual analysis of United Nations work programmes in relation to their budgetary implications.

4. The annex, in the first instance, serves to supplement the regular budget estimates which are presented to, and approved by, the General Assembly largely on the basis of object of expenditure. Furthermore, in addition to indicating the total costs of the various activities and programmes, the annex reveals the trend of such costs and their relation to total budgetary expenditure. Therefore, this presentation may facilitate the examination of the work programme financed from the regular budget from the standpoint of current or long-term policy objectives.

5. The same basic data have been used for the report of the Secretary-General<sup>2</sup> submitted to the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination of the Economic and Social Council on the work programme of the United Nations in the economic, social and human rights field and its budgetary requirements. Some of the basic statistics in the present annex also have been used, although in a different form and after incorporating information on extra-budgetary resources available for activities in the economic, social and human rights field, to provide the information required for inclusion in the report of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination to the Economic and Social Council on expenditures of the United Nations system in relation to programmes.<sup>3</sup>

6. The present annex consists of three main tables: Table A. Distribution of the expenditure estimates by main field of activity and programme and by object of expenditure, grouped in ten broad categories as indicated in the various schedules.

Table B. Consolidated statement of main activities and programmes in the economic, social and human rights field, the cost of each office being classified under four main groupings:

- A. Policy-making organs;
- B. Executive direction and management;
- C. Programme of activity;
- D. Administration and common services.

Table C. Analysis of income estimates by main field of activity and programme.

7. Table A represents the expenditures under the regular budget drawn up by object of expenditure on a three-year basis—1969 actual expenditure, 1970 appropriation and 1971 initial estimates as submitted by the Secretary-General to the General Assembly at its twenty-fourth session. The expenditure or provisions covered under each of the years concerned are grouped in ten broad categories:

- I. The General Assembly, commissions and committees
- II. Executive direction
- III. Political and Security Council activities
- IV. Trusteeship and questions related to the independence of colonial countries and peoples
- V. Economic, social and human rights activities
- VI. Legal activities
- VII. Public information
- VIII. Administration and common services
- IX. Conference services
- X. Other budgetary provisions

8. Further subdivisions are made under the main categories. There are eleven such subdivisions under the heading of economic, social and human rights activities, two under the heading of legal activities and four under the heading of administration and common services. Separate supporting schedules present further details on the items covered under each category or its subdivision.

9. Since, for purposes of assessment of Member States, total income, as reflected in the income sections of the budget, is deducted from the gross expenditure estimates, the costing of each item is presented both on a gross and a net basis.

10. The following information is provided in respect of the object of expenditure headings used in the various tables and schedules:

### Number of established posts

Shows the number of established posts of each category, subdivision of item (i) in the Professional and above and (ii) in the General Service categories. For 1969 and 1970 it presents the number of approved posts; for 1971 the number of posts as requested in the initial estimates of this document.

### (1) Salaries and wages—established posts

In 1969, covers the actual costs in accordance with the audited records for that year; in 1970 and 1971 the costs shown are based on the number of posts included in column 1 under the given item.

(2) Salaries and wages other than established posts	given in the brief description of the item under which the costs are shown.
Relates to costs of temporary assistance, experts and consultants, <i>ad hoc</i> expert groups, overtime and night differential as provided under all expenditure sections of the budget.	
(3) Common staff costs	(12) Total direct costs Represents the sum of columns 1 to 11.
Covers all common staff costs including home leave costs pro rated to the total of established posts shown under a given item.	(13) Distribution of conference services costs Shows the estimated share of conference costs attributed to each category, subdivision or item. In 1969, the share of these services has been allocated on the basis of actual workload statistics. (Statistics on workload data of conference services are maintained in the United Nations offices at Headquarters and Geneva and in the regional economic commissions—ECA, ECLA and ECAFE—in units of production by each function, such as the number of meetings or interpretation assignments, number of pages in translation, editing and typing, number of impressions in internal production and distribution; the total costs—salaries, common staff costs, travel, etc.—of each functional unit is then pro rated to the total units of production. In 1970 and 1971 the allocation in the conference services costs by main activity has been projected on the basis of experience for the last completed year—1969—and adjusted in the light of special circumstances estimated to prevail during the year concerned.
(4) Travel of representatives	
Relates to travel costs and subsistence of representatives of Member States and of members of committees and commissions, where appropriate.	
(5) Travel of staff	
Covers travel and subsistence of staff to meetings and official business provided under all sections of the budget for these purposes.	
(6) Printing	(14) Total cost (gross) Represents the total cost on the gross basis of each category, subdivision or item covered under the regular budget, including the relevant share of conference services costs. It represents the sum of columns 12 and 13. It also provides the relative value, expressed in terms of percentage, that each item bears to the total gross budget.
Relates to contractual printing costs; for 1969 these are based on actual records; in 1970 the costs shown are based on the appropriation figure for the year-end in accordance with the distribution approved by the Publications Board; in 1971 the costs represent estimates approved by the Publications Board but subject to approval by the General Assembly.	
(7) Special conferences and meetings	
Relate to costs of special conferences and meetings presented in the appropriate sections of the budget.	
(8) Permanent equipment	
(9) Maintenance, operation and rental of premises	
(10) General expenses	
Relate to costs specified under the particular headings.	
(11) Other	
Covers hospitality expenses and other costs that cannot be fitted in the preceding columns. In the latter case identification is	(15) Total cost (net) Covers the total cost on a net basis under the regular budget, i.e., the gross costs after deduction of the relevant share of staff assessment (levied on salaries and wages) and that of other income.

## ANNEX III

### ESTIMATES FOR 1971

#### International Narcotics Control Board

1. By virtue of a Protocol signed at New York on 11 December 1946, the United Nations has provided the administrative machinery and related requirements of, first, the Permanent Central Narcotics Board and the Drug Supervisory Body, and then, subsequent to 2 March 1968, of the International Narcotics Control Board which under the terms of the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, replaced the other two bodies as of that date.

2. The estimates for 1971 relating to the International Narcotics Control Board, which have been prepared in accordance with the procedure endorsed by the Economic and Social Council, are consolidated, under the appropriate sections, with the estimates of the United Nations. In the annual appropriation resolution it is specifically stated that the provisions under sections 1, 3, 5 and 11 relating to the International Narcotics Control Board shall be administered as a unit. This annex provides a summary of these estimates for 1971, compared with the corresponding figures for 1969 and 1970.
