Corrigendum

- 1. Following review of the negotiating text of the Convention by the International Panel of Experts on Desertification (IPED) and further review by the Secretariat, several changes and corrections are proposed. The only modifications of significance, which relate to the definitions and an addition to Article 22, are the result of suggestions by IPED members at their meeting held in Geneva, from 29 November to 1 December 1993.
- 2. Delegates are, therefore, invited to make the following changes to the negotiating text circulated as document A/AC.241/15. Most of the changes apply to all languages but several of them apply only to the French text.

Replace <u>autochtones</u> by <u>locales</u>

(b) Article 19 (1) (c), line 2:

Replace <u>indigènes</u> by <u>autochtones</u>

(c) Article 1 (1) (c), first two lines:

The first two lines of the definition of "land degradation" should read: "land degradation" means reduction or loss of the biological productivity and complexity of rainfed...

Replace the bracketed portion by: <u>0 degrees</u>

Replace exploiting fossil by suitable exploitation of ground

Replace <u>countries</u> by <u>country Parties</u>
