Working Group on Arbitrary Detention

Opinions adopted by the Working Group on Arbitrary Detention at its seventy-first session (17–21 November 2014)*

No. 51/2014 (Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela)

Communication addressed to the Government on 28 February 2014

Concerning: Maikel Giovanni Rondón Romero and 316 others

The Government replied to the communication on 28 April 2014 and provided additional information on 17 June 2014.

The State is a party to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.

1. The Working Group on Arbitrary Detention was established by the former Commission on Human Rights by its resolution 1991/42. The mandate of the Working Group was then clarified and extended by the Commission by its resolution 1997/50. The Human Rights Council assumed the mandate by its decision 2006/102 and extended it for a three-year period by its resolution 15/18 of 30 September 2010. The mandate was extended for a further three years by resolution 24/7 of 26 September 2013. Acting in accordance with its methods of work (A/HRC/16/47, annex), the Working Group transmitted the above-mentioned communication to the Government.

2. The Working Group regards deprivation of liberty as arbitrary in the following cases:

(a) When it is clearly impossible to invoke any legal basis justifying the deprivation of liberty (as when a person is kept in detention after the completion of his or her sentence or despite an amnesty law applicable to the detainee) (category I);

(b) When the deprivation of liberty results from the exercise of the rights or freedoms guaranteed by articles 7, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and, insofar as States parties are concerned, by articles 12, 18, 19, 21, 22, 25, 26 and 27 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (category II);

(c) When the total or partial non-observance of the international norms relating to the right to a fair trial, established in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and in the relevant international instruments accepted by the States concerned, is of such gravity as to give the deprivation of liberty an arbitrary character (category III);

(d) When asylum seekers, immigrants or refugees are subjected to prolonged administrative custody without the possibility of administrative or judicial review or remedy (category IV);

(e) When the deprivation of liberty constitutes a violation of international law for reasons of discrimination based on birth; national, ethnic or social origin; language; religion; economic condition; political or other opinion; gender; sexual orientation; or disability or other status, and which aims towards or can result in ignoring the equality of human rights (category V).

Submissions

Communication from the source

3. According to the information provided by the source in the allegation letter, a substantial number of persons were arbitrarily detained between 9 and 20 February 2014 in connection with various peaceful protests held to express students' concern for their future, the future of the country and the consequences of the crisis besetting the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela. The persons deprived of their liberty whose names appear in the source's allegation letter are listed in annex I to this opinion. Annex II contains the names of the persons who were detained and the date and place of their detention.

4. The source affirms that other persons were also detained but that they were not brought before a judge; they were subsequently released by decision of the police, but their detention was not registered. In the cases of the other detainees, judges ordered that they should be released definitively or placed under house arrest (home detention).

5. Other persons have had their rights restricted by court decision in a number of ways. They have been required to report periodically to a judge, banned from leaving their town of residence or prohibited from taking part in rallies or demonstrations. According to the source, such restrictions violate their fundamental rights and the freedoms of opinion, expression, assembly, association and demonstration.

6. The source states that 94 persons have been released by court order subject to certain conditions. In the vast majority of cases, criminal proceedings have been brought against the persons who were detained.

7. Most of those detained were arrested without a warrant. Many of them were not brought promptly before the judicial authorities, in violation of the time limits prescribed by the law. They were prevented from contacting family members, and lawyers were denied access to police stations and military facilities.

8. The source reports that a number of the persons detained were subjected to torture and cruel, inhuman, humiliating and degrading treatment by military personnel and State agents. Some detainees were beaten severely, while others were sexually assaulted. Their personal belongings, in particular electronic equipment such as cameras and mobile telephones, were inspected, seized or damaged.

9. According to the source, these persons were detained merely because they were taking part in peaceful student demonstrations that the government authorities had been opposed to from the outset.

10. The source adds that the detainees were transferred to places which failed to meet the minimum requirements for guaranteeing their fundamental rights inasmuch as they lacked adequate ventilation, lighting and temperature control. Minors were held in places of detention for adults and together with adults.

11. Action taken by the State following these mass detentions failed to meet due process requirements. In many instances, the periods of detention exceeded the time limits established by law for the presentation of the detainees before a judge.

12. The source reports that in some instances temporary judges, who do not enjoy the necessary guarantee of independence from the executive branch, exerted pressure on the detainees, threatening that they would not be granted conditional release if they requested medical or forensic reports to be prepared concerning the assaults to which they had been subjected.

13. The source states that, following these detentions, the Office of the Attorney General did not carry out the necessary investigations with due diligence, thereby failing to fulfil the State's international and constitutional obligations. In many instances, officials refused to record the allegations of torture and assault. This amounts to a serious dereliction of their institutional duties.

14. According to the source, the detention of these 407 individuals is arbitrary, given that it is contrary to articles 9, 10, 19 and 20 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and articles 9, 14, 19 and 22 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, to which the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela is a party.

Response from the Government

15. The Government replied to the communication on 28 April 2014.

16. The Government states that in 2013 Nicolás Maduro Moros was elected President of the Republic and that the political forces supporting him subsequently won an overwhelming victory in municipal elections. In early 2014, sectors of the opposition called a demonstration for 12 February, which they called *La Salida* (The Way Out), with the aim of mobilizing the most radical opposition groups and overthrowing the President of the Republic.

17. The Government asserts that the legitimate right to demonstration and peaceful protest without arms was abused, and the situation turned violent in the cities of Barcelona, Barinas, Barquisimeto, Caracas, Cumana, Guarenas, Los Teques, Maracaibo, Maracay, Puerto Cabello, Puerto Ordaz, San Cristóbal, Trujillo and Valencia. According to the information provided by the Government, there were outbreaks of violence in 8 of the country's 335 municipalities.

18. The Government states that a series of violent incidents occurred, including physical assaults on individuals and damage to public and private property. In its reply, it asserts that specially trained groups blocked streets, avenues and airports and thus infringed the rights to free movement, food, education, physical and mental health, peaceful protest, recreation, medical assistance, tranquillity, peaceful coexistence and a healthy environment. It reports that large national and international corporations, via their media platforms, used artists, musicians, singers and actors to discredit the Venezuelan authorities. The media used social networks to give the impression that Venezuela was in the throes of a deep political crisis requiring urgent foreign intervention.

19. The Government states that, in the course of these protests, 39 people were killed (31 civilians and 8 officers from various institutions) and 650 were injured; in addition, attacks were carried out on a building housing the Office of the Ombudsman, 18 public health facilities, 8 schools and 5 political party offices. It reports that 5,000 mature trees

were felled in order to block roads; a drinking water reservoir was contaminated; fires were set that burned 25 hectares of the Guaraira Repano National Park; and a nursery school in Chacao Municipality in the Caracas metropolitan area was firebombed.

20. The Government further reports that three people died during the 12 February protests and that, in that connection, officials from the Bolivarian National Intelligence Service are being investigated as suspects, having acted outside their powers — which do not include policing demonstrations — and disobeyed an order to remain in their barracks.

21. The Government states that 2,153 people, including 861 students, were brought before the courts in February and March 2014. The Government considers that “all those deprived of their liberty” carried out criminal acts and that none of them were arrested for demonstrating peacefully. According to the Government, the detainees are being investigated for their possible involvement in the following offences: murder (article 405 of the Criminal Code); blocking the public thoroughfare (art. 357); incitement to public disorder (art. 285); damage to public property (art. 473); personal injury (art. 413); arson (art. 343); and inducing adolescents to commit offences (article 264 of the Child and Adolescent Protection Act). The Government provides information on the names of the persons arrested, the place of their detention and the nature of the offence with which they are charged, as well as other details, including, where applicable, the legal grounds for having released some of the detainees.

22. The Government reports that, in most instances, the courts have applied alternative measures to deprivation of freedom, thus allowing the persons concerned to remain free while standing trial. Such measures include reporting periodically to the court and refraining from participating in demonstrations. According to the Government, the persons were arrested in flagrante delicto, in accordance with article 234 of the Code of Criminal Procedure; consequently, arrest warrants were not required.

23. The Government states that public defenders are representing those detainees who requested their services and that all the persons deprived of their liberty have been guaranteed due process; they were all brought before a duly appointed judge in the presence of their defence counsel within 48 hours after their arrest.

24. On 17 June 2014, the Government confirmed the information that it had provided concerning these cases. According to a Public Prosecution Service report dated 27 March 2014, only 168 persons were still subject to a detention order. The Government states that, according to the records of the Public Prosecution Service, 23 of the individuals mentioned were never detained. The Government acknowledges that the persons listed in annex III were detained in connection with the demonstrations; their names matched those provided in the source’s additional submission.

25. The Government further states that there have been no cases whatsoever of arbitrary detention in Venezuela. No one has been arrested for participating in peaceful demonstrations. Those who were arrested were involved in violent acts that violated the rights to personal integrity, freedom of movement, public and private property and a healthy environment.

Comments from the source

26. On 13 November 2014, the source submitted comments on the information provided by the Government. The source states that, although the communication and the Government’s reply refer to the period from 9 to 20 February 2014, a total of 3,400 people were detained in connection with the demonstrations in the period up to 13 November 2014, including 2,579 students. On that date, 1,907 persons were still subject to criminal proceedings and under court supervision; and 78 remained in detention by court order.

27. The source further states that the number of persons deprived of their liberty in connection with the demonstrations given in the original communication was an initial figure and that, in fact, a total of 543 people were detained. Notwithstanding the new information provided by the source, the Working Group will confine itself to the allegations regarding the detentions referred to in the initial submission (see para. 3 above), to which the Government has had an opportunity to respond.

28. In all the cases that have been reported, with the exception of the case of the political leader Leopoldo López Mendoza in respect of which the Working Group has issued a separate opinion (A/HRC/WGAD/2014/26), the arrests were made without a warrant. According to the police records, the persons detained were allegedly caught in flagrante delicto.

29. In the cases originally reported, criminal proceedings were opened against the detainees on the dates indicated, except in the cases of those persons who were released without being brought before a court. It should be noted that the Government confirms most of the names contained in the communication and does not rule out the possibility that all of the detentions mentioned in paragraph 3 above may have occurred; it states only that some of the persons could not be identified and that their names do not appear in the records of the Public Prosecution Service. The Government does not deny that people have been taken into custody without being registered by government authorities. In fact, it reports a much higher figure than that presented by the source in the original communication.

30. The source states that in none of the cases of detention that occurred between 9 and 20 February 2014 has anyone been released, acquitted definitively or had his or her case dismissed. In cases where people have been granted conditional release, the Public Prosecution Service has continued to conduct criminal investigations under the “standard procedure”. Furthermore, the Government acknowledges that several persons are still deprived of their liberty, while others are on conditional release or under house arrest.

31. According to the source, in all the reported cases of detention, the persons were held first in military facilities or, in some instances, in police stations. The reason for this is that the arresting officers were almost all members of a military body, specifically the Bolivarian National Guard. In most cases, following their arrest, the detainees were taken directly to one of the National Guard headquarters or barracks; in Caracas, they were taken to the main military base at Fort Tiuna.

32. The source states that acts of torture and ill-treatment were committed in 19 cases. The names of the persons allegedly tortured are as follows:

33. The source further reports that some of the cases were found to involve the detention of persons under the age of 18. According to the source, in all these cases the minors concerned were held together with adults or in places of detention for adults in police or military facilities until they were brought before special courts with jurisdiction over criminal cases involving juveniles.

Discussion

34. Having reviewed the documents submitted to it by the source and the Government, the Working Group considers it appropriate to group the cases of all the persons mentioned in paragraph 3 in a single opinion, since the detention and release of those persons and the subsequent prosecution of some of the cases all occurred in connection with the demonstrations held from 9 to 20 February 2014. Furthermore, the cases are treated together as a single group in both the source's allegations and the Government's reply and additional submission, even though information is provided on the cases individually.

35. The Working Group notes that, in connection with the demonstrations held from 9 to 20 February 2014, people were subjected to mass arrests and charged with various offences by the authorities of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela. The Government acknowledges that (except in the above-mentioned case of Leopoldo López Mendoza, which was the subject of a separate opinion of the Working Group) none of these arrests was carried out pursuant to a court order, as they were allegedly made in flagrante delicto.

36. The Working Group is of the view that the Government has failed to take advantage of the opportunity to give a detailed explanation as to the place, time and manner of the arrests, as to how the persons detained allegedly committed the offences or as to the manner in which the competent authorities detained them. Nor has it demonstrated that the detentions, which are alleged to be arbitrary by the source, were made in accordance with applicable constitutional and international obligations. Moreover, the Government has not ruled out the possibility that all of the detentions referred to in paragraph 3 above may have occurred; it only states that some of the names provided by the source do not appear in the records of the Public Prosecution Service.

37. The Working Group notes that both sources of information confirm that most of the persons allegedly detained in flagrante delicto were released without charges. In a number of other cases, the judicial authorities ordered their conditional release subject to specified precautionary measures. These measures prevented the detainees from exercising their right to freedom of expression and assembly inasmuch as the persons concerned were required to refrain from participating in demonstrations or protests; failure to do so would place them in contempt of court. In view of the foregoing, the Working Group finds that the persons concerned were deprived of their liberty in order to inhibit or restrict their right to the freedom of expression and assembly.

38. The Working Group notes that Christian René Holdack Hernández is still being held in detention while awaiting trial for offences allegedly committed in connection with the demonstrations held from 9 to 20 February 2014. The Government has not provided information as to why this person remains in detention while others have been released.

39. Consequently, the Working Group regards as *prima facie* credible the source's account that the persons in question were detained en masse while exercising their freedoms of expression and assembly, as set forth in articles 19 and 20 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and articles 19 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. The Working Group thus considers that those persons were detained by the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela in a manner that constitutes arbitrary detention under category II of the Working Group's methods of work.

40. The Working Group is alarmed by the allegations of torture and ill-treatment. As these claims do not come within its competence, however, it will refer the matter to the Special Rapporteur on the question of torture for action in accordance with the mandate conferred on him by the Human Rights Council.

Disposition

41. In the light of the above, and despite the fact the most of the persons mentioned in the source's original communication are no longer deprived of their liberty, the Working Group, acting in accordance with paragraph 17 (a) of its methods of work (A/HRC/16/47, annex), renders the following opinion:

The deprivation of liberty of the persons mentioned in annex I of the present document, in connection with the demonstrations held from 9 to 20 February 2014 in various localities of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, was arbitrary, being in contravention of articles 19 and 20 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and articles 19 and 21 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; it falls within category II of the arbitrary detention categories referred to by the Working Group when considering cases submitted to it.

42. With regard to those persons who continue to be deprived of their liberty and who are charged with offences allegedly committed in connection with those demonstrations, the Working Group requests the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela to immediately release those persons whom it continues to detain.

43. The Working Group also requests the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela to ensure that the precautionary measures ordered to restrict the freedoms of expression and peaceful assembly and demonstration are declared invalid by the competent authorities and that they are not applied in the meantime, since they violate the State's obligations under the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.

44. Consequent upon the opinion rendered, the Working Group requests the Government of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela to take the necessary steps to remedy the situation of all the persons arbitrarily deprived of their liberty in conformity with the provisions of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.

45. In accordance with paragraph 33 (a) of its methods of work, the Working Group considers it appropriate to refer the allegations concerning 19 cases of torture or cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment to the Special Rapporteur on the question of torture.
