## Corrigendum

- Paragraph 82, substitute following for third sentence: "In the manufacture of tread 100 parts of rubber, 45 parts of carbon black and 15 to 20 parts of all other chemicals included under accelerators, sulphur, activators, antioxidants and softeners are used".
- 2. Paragraph 83, third line, substitute "channel" for "chemical".
- 3. <u>Mauritius</u> Paragraph 57, Table X, Paragraph 99(5) and Chart, page 53.

Information received from Mauritius after this document was prepared indicates that a rubber-canvas shoe factory already exists at Port Louis and that a plastic shoe factory is to be established. The total production of shoes in Mauritius is estimated at 600,000 pairs per annum. Our recommendation in respect of a canvas-rubber factory is therefore not valid, and we suggest that the existing factory also produce bicycle tyres and tubes, soles and heels and moulded rubber goods.
