(Report by the Secretary-General)

  - 3. The Commission may wish to express its view on the study and the comments and discuss the form of the publication. The study may be published in the form given and perhaps, in addition, in the form showing the reverse relationship, i.e. linking the International Standard Industrial Classification to the Standard International Trade Classification.

### CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES BY INDUSTRIAL ORIGIN

Relationship of the Standard International Trade Classification to the International Standard Industrial Classification

The Statistical Commission at its 12th session requested the Statistical Office of the United Nations to undertake a study relating the items of the Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C.) to the groups of the International Standard Industrial Classification (I.S.I.C.). The results of the study are presented here, in preliminary form, for the purpose of enabling national statistical offices, regional organisations and other users to offer their comments and suggestions for consideration by the Statistical Commission before the document is issued in final form.

In requesting this study the Commission was guided by the need expressed by a number of countries for a document which would indicate for the wide range of commodities entering world trade the industries from which they normally flow. will be recognised that many commodities, particularly processed goods whose value consists in a high proportion of industrial value added, have achieved their final state as a result of contributions from a number of different industries. For many kinds of economic analysis there is a need for a classification which would show for each commodity not only the industries which contributed to its final form but also the proportion of the final value contributed by each separate industrial activity. This is attempted by many countries through input-output analysis. All that is attempted in the present study, however, is a link between commodities and the industries from which they normally flow in the form in which they are described in the S.I.T.C. The normality here involved is the practice of the majority of countries producing commercially and exporting the commodities specified. It is felt that the link which this study establishes between the trade classification which is a commodity classification and the industrial classification which is concerned with activities, will be of particular use in industrial census and similar enquiries where it is necessary to determine the commodity composition resulting from the industrial activity considered.

For this study the latest issues of the two classifications containing alphabetic indexes were used viz:- Statistical Papers, Series M, No.4, Rev. 1, Add.1, Indexes to the International Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities and Series M, No. 38, Vols. I and II, Commodity Indexes for the International Trade Classification, Revised.

The study is presented together with a Supplement. The main study shows opposite each item of the S.I.T.C. the number of the corresponding group of the I.S.I.C. In those cases where an S.I.T.C. item corresponds to two or more I.S.I.C. groups, the numbers of those groups are shown in the main study and a description is given in the Supplement of the composition of each part of the S.I.T.C. item that corresponds to each I.S.I.C. group. The classification of the items of the S.I.T.C. according to industrial origin was effected firstly, by determining the economic activities which resulted in the production of the commodities covered by that S.I.T.C. item and, secondly, by ascertaining the I.S.I.C. industrial group in which the establishments which carry out these activities are classified. All this classification work was carried out according to the provisions of the I.S.I.C.

In certain cases, it is the national practice to use a local unit, rather than the establishment within an industry as defined by an I.S.I.C. group. The local unit may engage in activities belonging to more than one I.S.I.C. group. In such cases it is necessary to classify the local unit to the I.S.I.C. group appropriate to the activities contributing the greater proportion of the value added (or employment or gross value as the case may be).

For the purpose of this study, the commodities of the groups and items of the S.I.T.C. were regarded as being produced by establishments all the activities of which fell into a single group of the I.S.I.C. By-products and wastes were classified according to main products, e.g. oil seed cake to vegetable oils.

The groups •r items of the S.I.T.C. are rarely composed of single commodities but are usually made up of a varying number of commodities. Five possibilities were encountered when classifying the commodities comprising an S.I.T.C. item. (1) one commodity resulting from single economic activity. (2) a number of commodities resulting from activities all of which fall into one I.S.I.C. group. (3) a number of commodities some of which result from activities falling into one I.S.I.C. group and others resulting from activities falling into other I.S.I.C. groups. In these cases the numbers of the corresponding I.S.I.C. groups are shown in the main study and details concerning the commodities belonging to each I.S.I.C. group are given, in most instances, in the Supplement. (4) by-products and wastes which were classified according to the activities producing their associated principal products. In the case of wastes it was impossible to enumerate all the I.S.I.C. groups to which they might belong and only a few of the leading groups are given. (5) used articles such as metal scrap and old clothing, were classified into trades, I.S.I.C. 611.
