II. Утверждение повестки дня и организация работы

А. Открытие и продолжительность работы сессии

- 1. Комиссия по правам человека провела свою шестьдесят вторую сессию в Отделении Организации Объединенных Наций в Женеве 16 января и 13-27 марта 2006 года (см. также пункты 10 и11 ниже). В ходе сессии было проведено четыре заседания (см. E/CN.4/2006/SR.1-4)¹.
- 2. Сессию открыл г-н Макарим Вибисоно, Председатель Комиссии на ее шестьдесят первой сессии.
- 3. На 1-м заседании 16 января 2006 года и на 4-м заседании 27 марта с заявлениями выступила г-жа Луиза Арбур, Верховный комиссар Организации Объединенных Наций по правам человека.

В. Участники

4. В работе сессии приняли участие представители государств - членов Комиссии, наблюдатели от других государств - членов Организации Объединенных Наций, наблюдатели от государств, не являющихся членами Организации, а также наблюдатели от специализированных учреждений, региональных межправительственных организаций, других органов и неправительственных организаций. Список участников приводится в приложении III к настоящему докладу.

С. Выборы должностных лиц

5. На своем 1-м заседании Комиссия избрала путем аккламации следующих должностных лиц:

- 6. На этом же заседании с заявлениями в связи с избранием должностных лиц выступили представители Мексики (от имени Группы государств Латинской Америки и Карибского бассейна) и Нидерландов (от имени Группы западноевропейских и других государств).
- 7. С заявлениями выступили также представители Марокко (от имени Группы африканских государств), Саудовской Аравии (от имени Группы азиатских государств), Азербайджана (от имени Группы восточноевропейских государств) и Пакистана (от имени Организации Исламская конференция), а также представитель Конференции неправительственных организаций (КОНПО).

D. Повестка дня

8. На 4-м заседании 27 марта 2006 года Комиссия рассмотрела и приняла без голосования повестку дня шестьдесят второй сессии (E/CN.4/2006/L.1), которая была подготовлена должностными лицами Комиссии при том понимании, что цель пункта 6 постановляющей части резолюции 60/251 Генеральной Ассамблеи от 15 марта 2006 года заключается в том, что Генеральная Ассамблея передает Совету по правам человека все существующие мандаты, механизмы, функции и обязанности Комиссии, которые существовали на момент принятия этой резолюции, и поэтому от Комиссии не требуется каких-либо решений по их продлению или передаче. Е. Организация работы

- 9. Комиссия рассмотрела вопрос об организации своей работы на своем 4-м заседании 27 марта 2006 года.

- 11. На 3-м заседании 20 марта Комиссия по рекомендации своих должностных лиц приняла без голосования решение приостановить работу сессии на одну неделю до 27 марта 2006 года.
